

Throughout, DeLatte emphasizes Lucy Audubons own experiences, concerns, and point of view. She tells of Lucys often stormy relationship with her brilliant but unreliable husband, her place at the head of their small family, and her crucial role in the creation and publication of her husbands magnum opus. Intelligent, adaptable, and strong-willed, Lucy was, DeLatte shows, the partner Audubon needed for his life and for his work. As noted Audubon expert Christoph Irmscher says in his foreword, When [DeLatte] slips into her characters skin, she does so unobtrusively and to great effect -thus, we are right there with Lucy.
