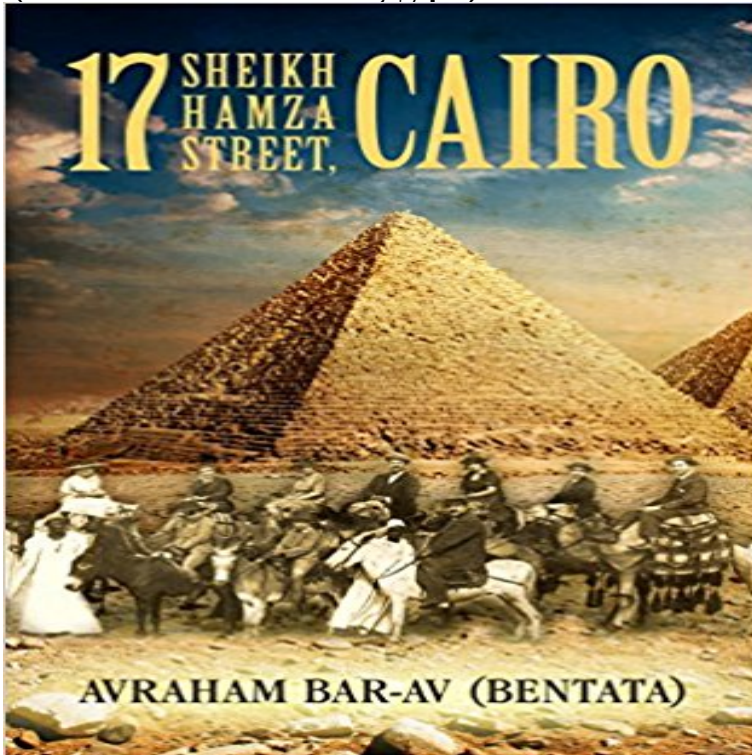


17 Sheikh Hamza Street, Cairo: A Middle Eastern Historical Fiction (Memories From Egypt)

She may either buy his incriminating documents one by one or buy the whole lot of them together. Hosni is not picky about the payment method: Payment can take the form of money or gold or jewelry. If you'd rather not part with your belongings, an intimate encounter is also an option. The family's life in Egypt has hit a dead end. In the face of catastrophe, family members hurry to flee from Egypt. One part of the family escapes to Israel, others spread out to find refuge in France, Italy and Australia.???.
