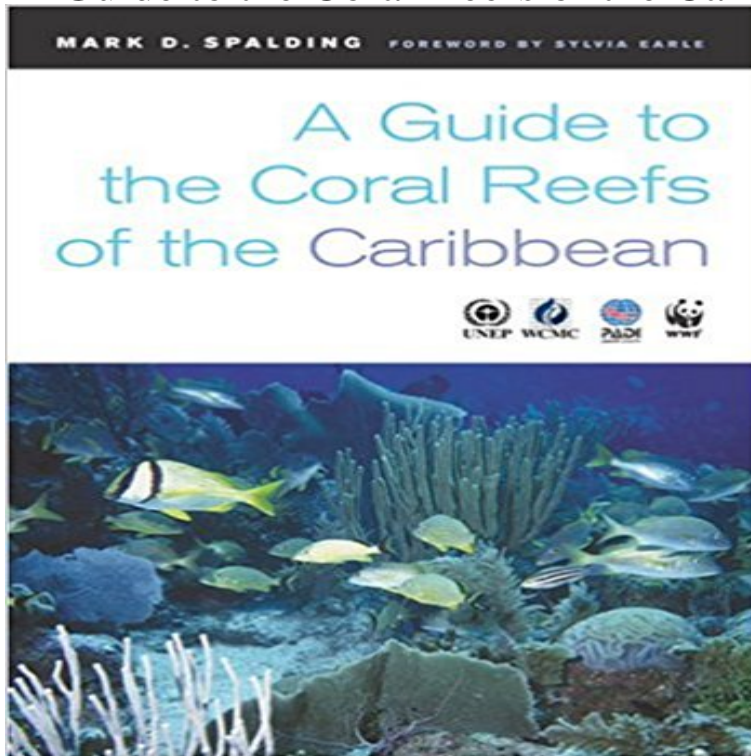


# A Guide to the Coral Reefs of the Caribbean
