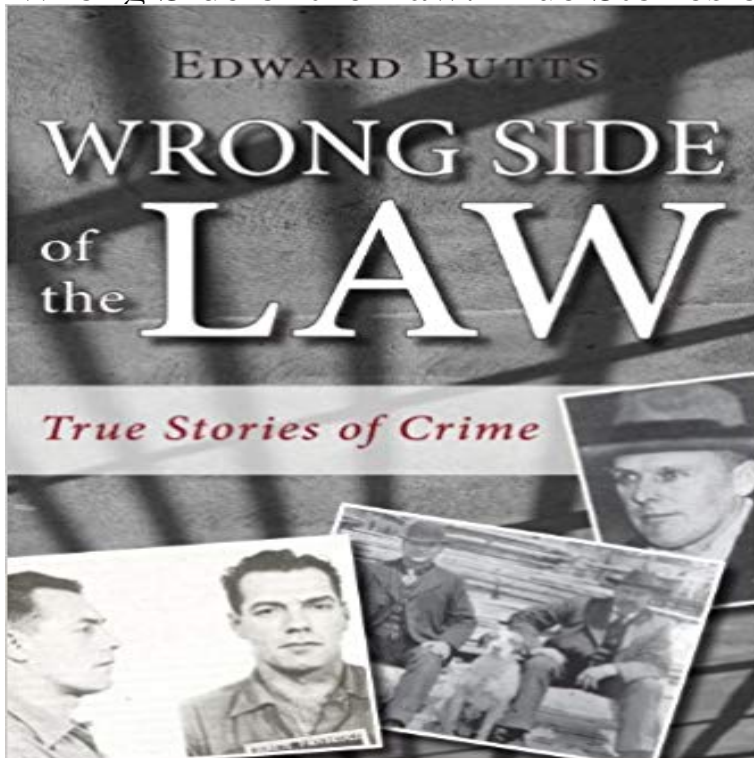


## Wrong Side of the Law: True Stories of Crime
