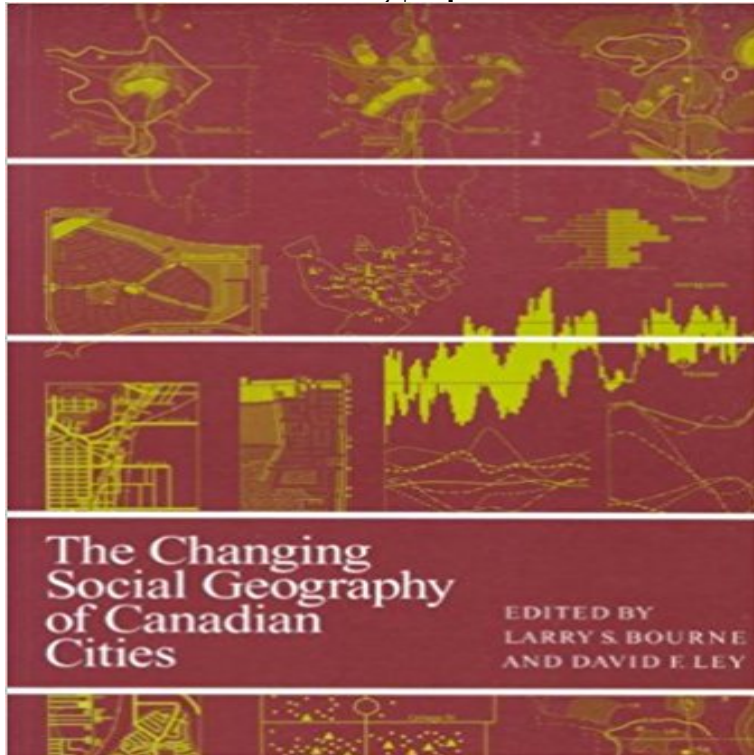


The Changing Social Geography of Canadian Cities (Canadian Association of Geographers Series in Canadian Geography)
