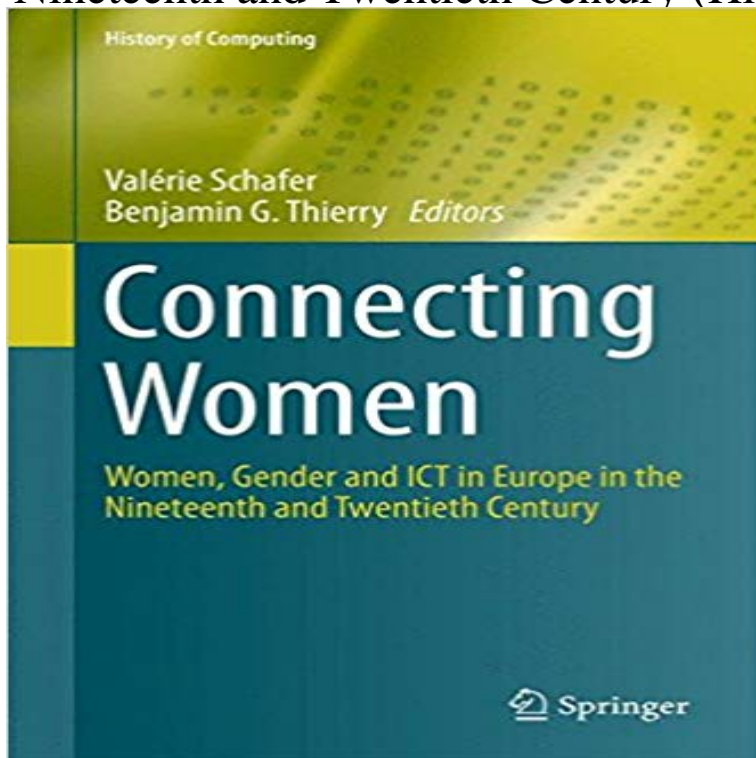


Connecting Women: Women, Gender and ICT in Europe in the Nineteenth and Twentieth Century (History of Computing)
