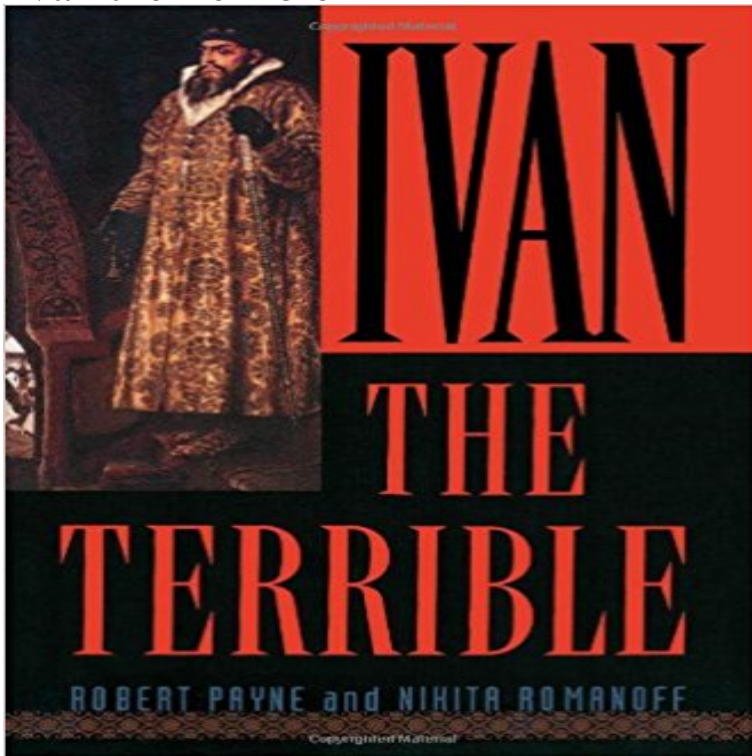


Ivan the Terrible
