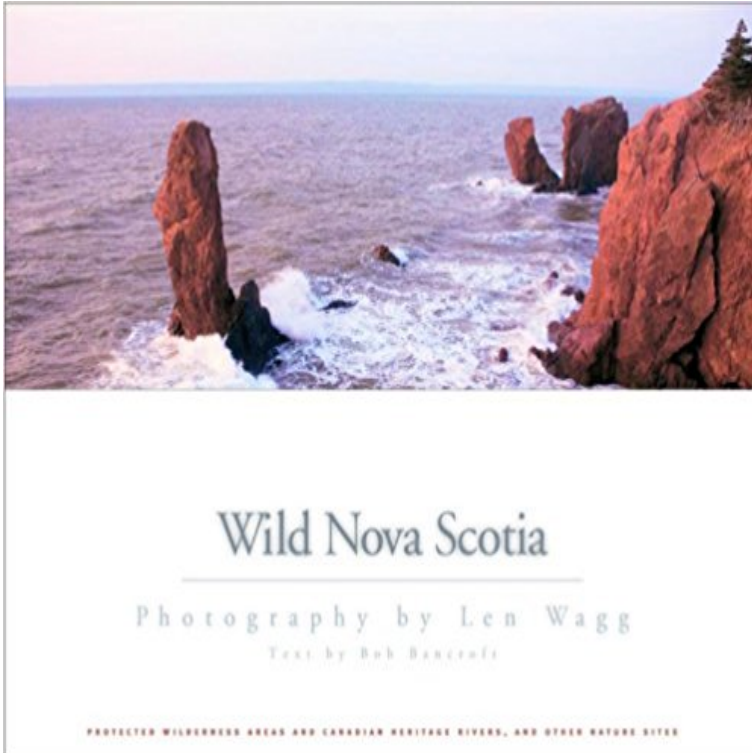


Wild Nova Scotia
