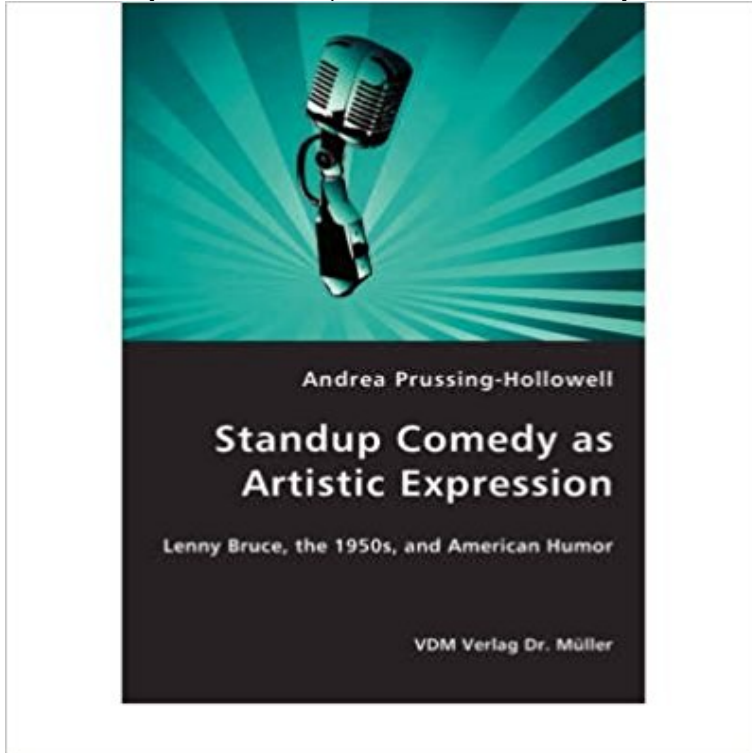


Standup Comedy as Artistic Expression (Paperback) - Common
