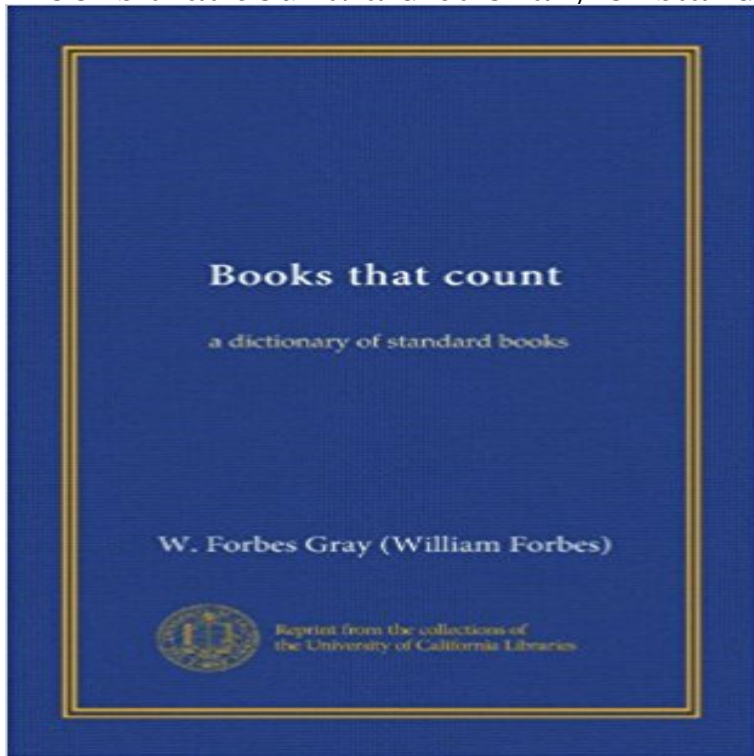


Books that count: a dictionary of standard books
