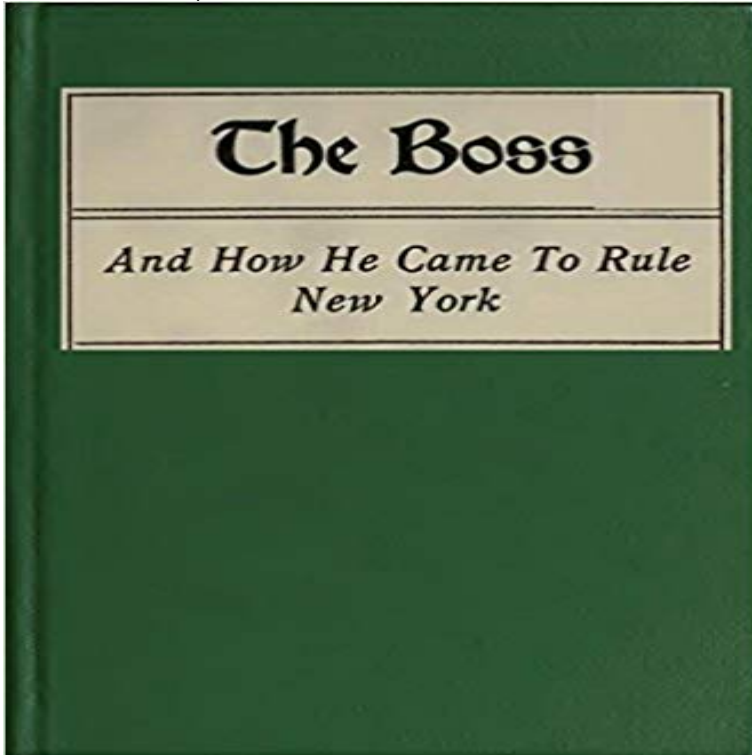


The Boss, And How He Came To Rule New York
