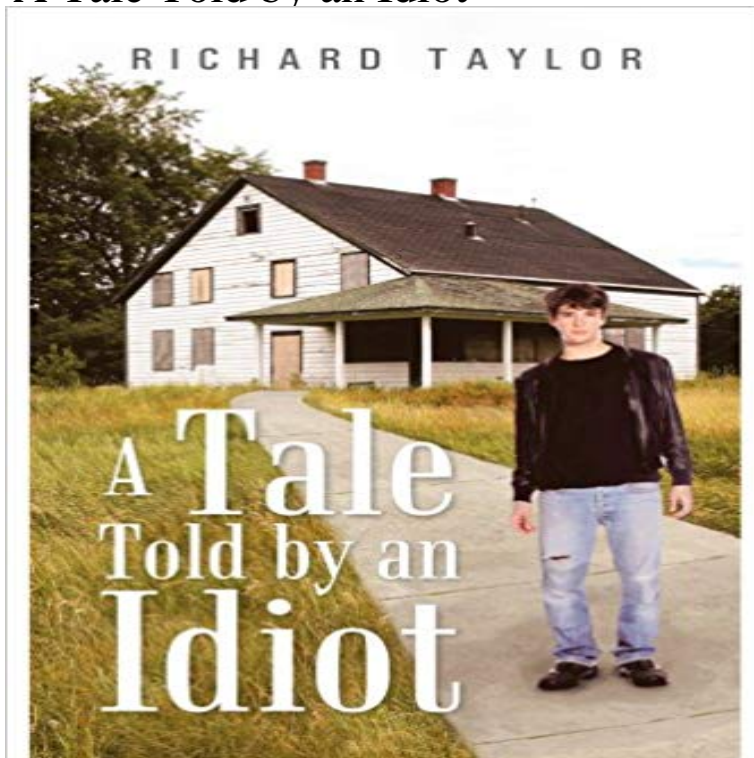


A Tale Told by an Idiot
