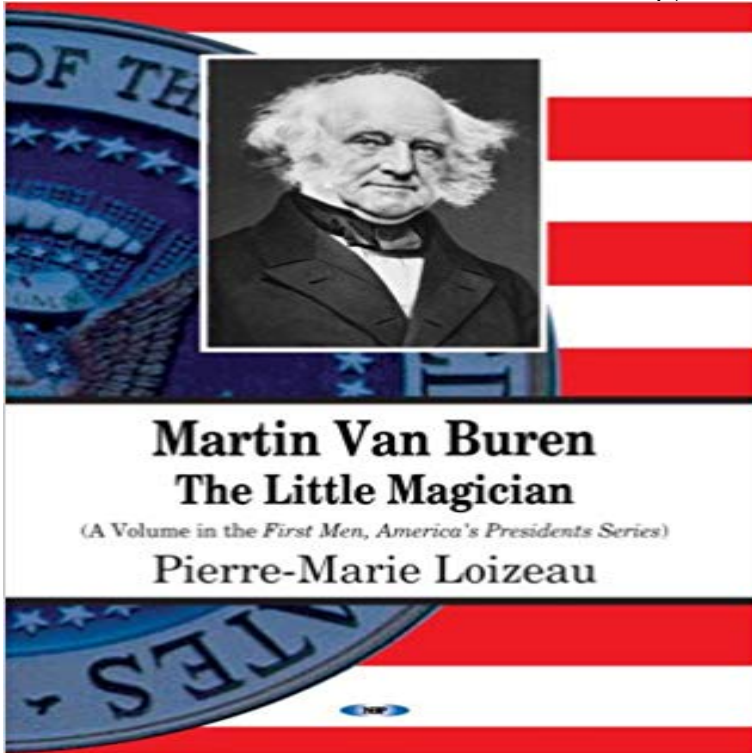


## Martin Van Buren: The Little Magician (First Men, Americas Presidents)

Blessed with sound political acumen but despised for his constant political manoeuvring, he was known as the Little Magician by his friends and enemies alike, with different motives. As president, Van Buren was beset with the Panic of 1837, a strong economic recession resulting mostly from his predecessors' wrong choices, but for which he paid a strong political price.
