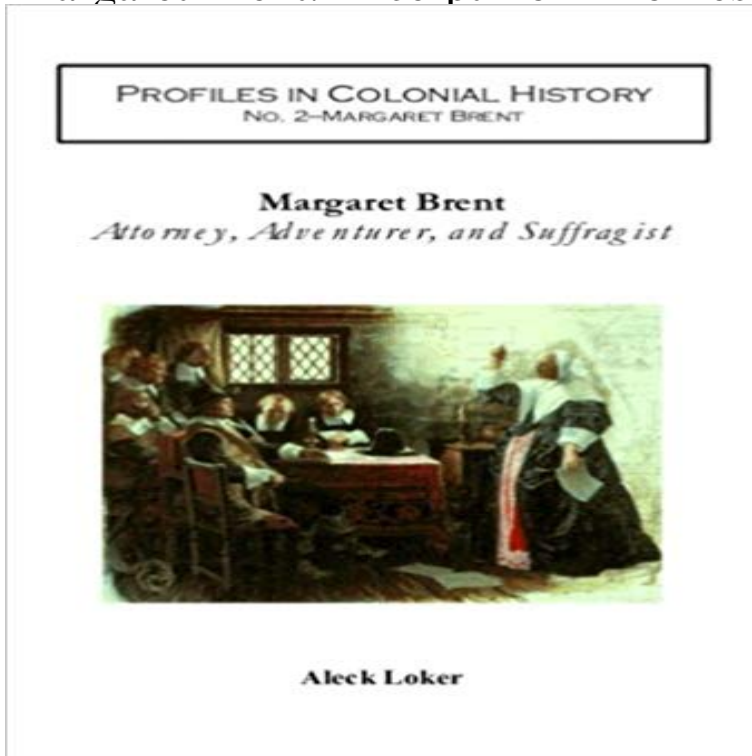


Margaret Brent: Excerpt from Profiles in Colonial History
