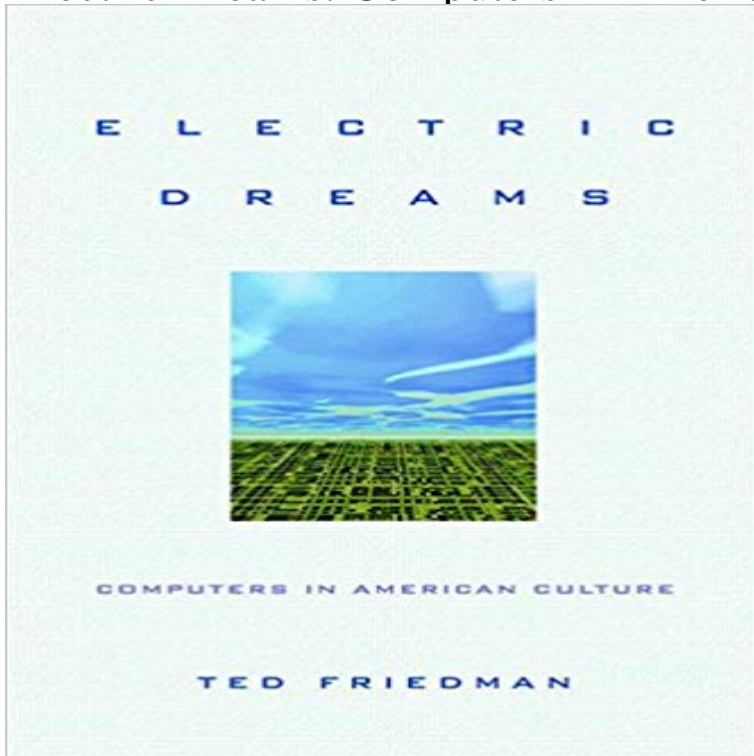


# Electric Dreams: Computers in American Culture
