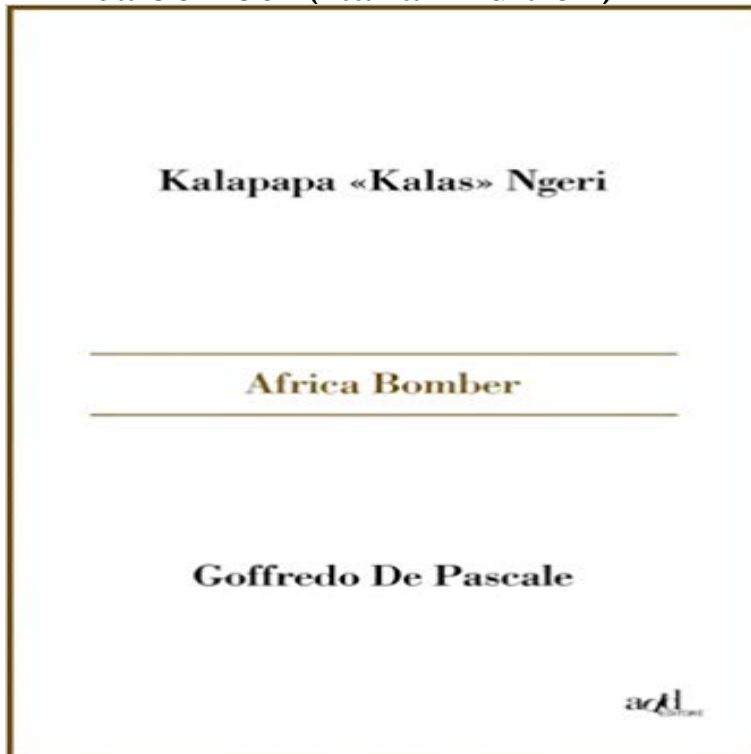


Africa bomber (Italian Edition)
