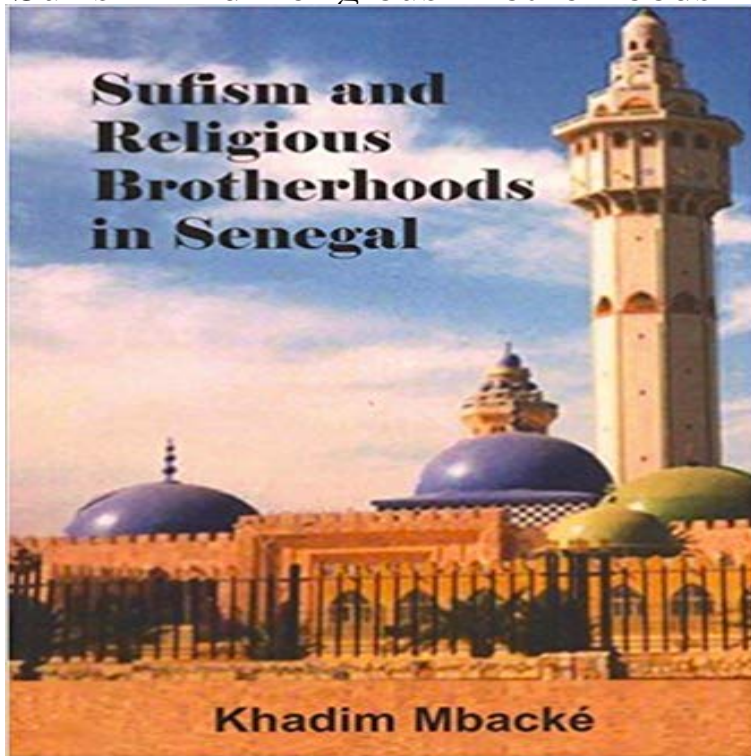


Sufism And Religious Brotherhoods In Senegal

Mbacke traces the genesis and evolution of Sufism in order to explain the circumstances that permitted the emergence of Sufi brotherhoods. He describes the brotherhoods that are currently active in Senegal and depicts the means and manner of their diffusion, the lives of their founding figures, their basic teachings, their internal organization, the links they maintain with each other, and the role they play in the countrys cultural, economic, social and political life. The book uses its study of the present condition of Senegals Sufi brotherhoods to speculate on their future evolution.
