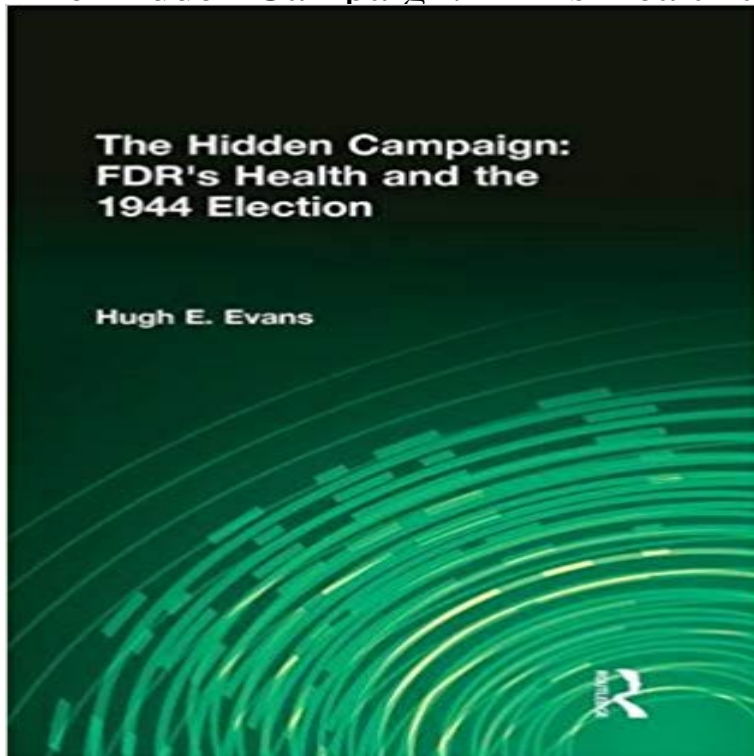


The Hidden Campaign: FDRs Health and the 1944 Election

Yet although only 62, Roosevelt was mortally ill with congestive heart disease - a fact that was carefully shielded from the American public prior to the election of 1944. In a media environment where we get more details about politicians health than we sometimes prefer, it is hard to imagine how a paper as authoritative as The New York Times could describe FDRs death as sudden and unexpected on its front page. Dr. Hugh Evans looks at the issue of Roosevelts health not only from a medical ethics perspective, but also with a keen eye for the political and media considerations that led to the decision to run and not disclose the extent of Roosevelts illness.
