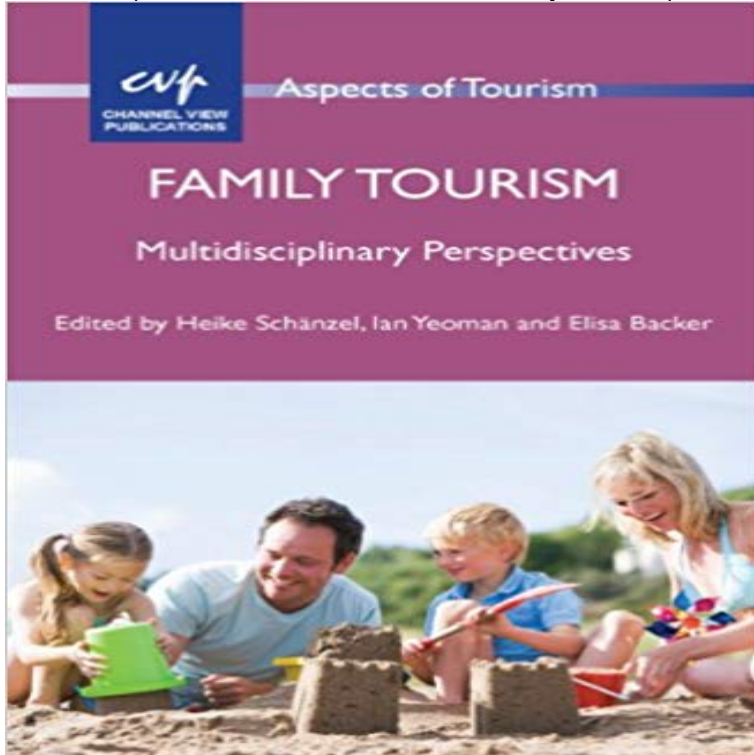


Family Tourism: Multidisciplinary Perspectives (Aspects of Tourism)
