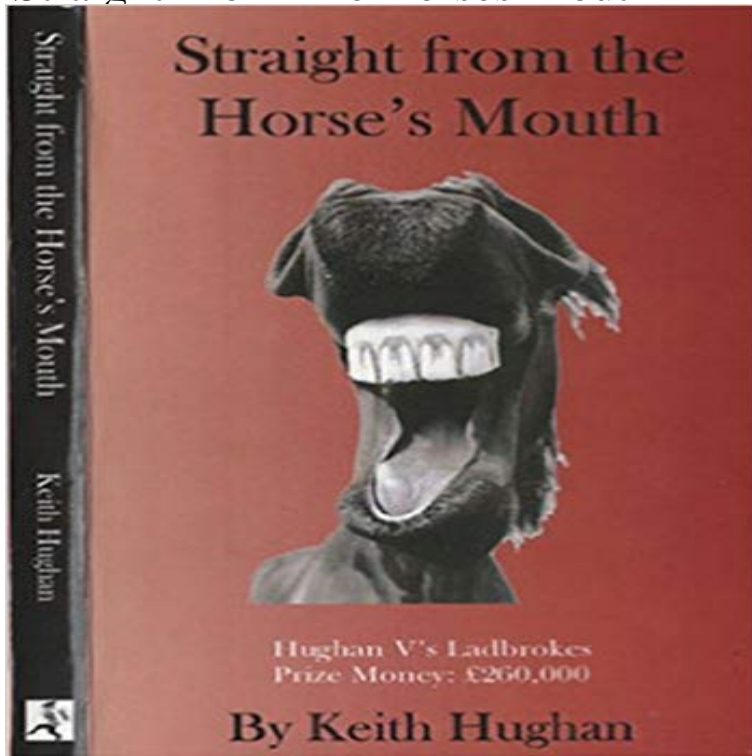


Straight From The Horses Mouth
