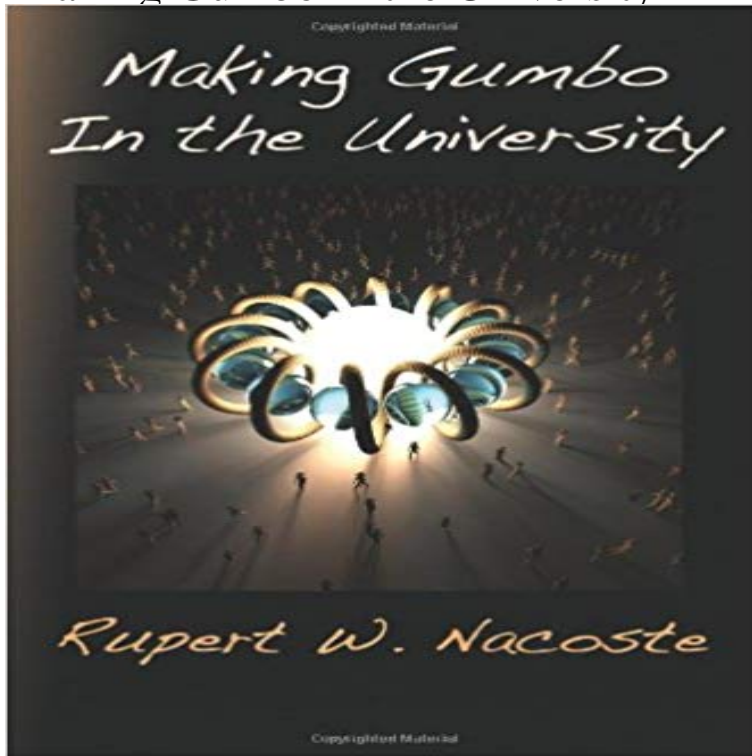


Making Gumbo In the University



Daddy liked his conversation the way he liked his gumbo. So begins the story that leads up to Chancellor Marye Anne Fox being formally reprimanded by the North Carolina State University faculty.

What did that have to do with Gumbo? Drawing on his Louisiana black-Creole roots for the guiding metaphor, *Making Gumbo In the University* is the story of Professor Rupert W. Nacoste's life of work on diversity, especially his two years as the ranking university administrator responsible for diversity at North Carolina State University. Rupert Nacoste's life has been all about trying to make gumbo. ---
